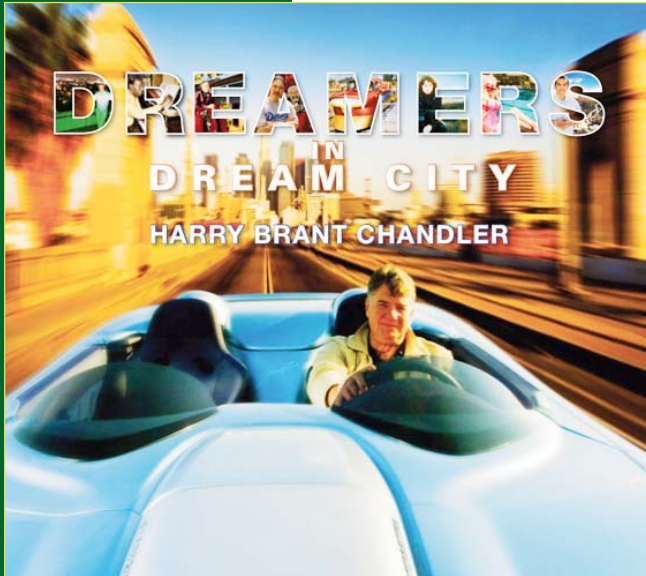

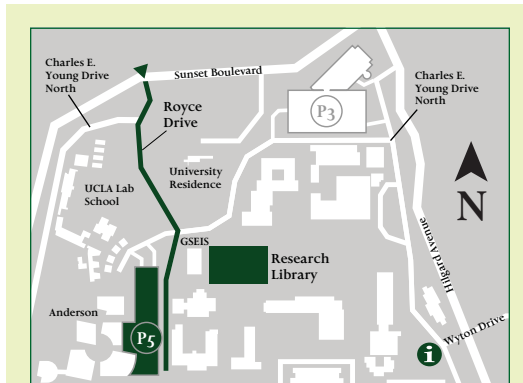
Photographer and biographer Harry Chandler will discuss his recent book *Dreamers in Dream City*.
